2. Individual tutorial sessions.
3. Ensemble sessions.

YOUR VENUE FOR THE WEEKEND

WHERE WE ARE

Waddow Hall is a beautiful Manor House situated on the banks of the River Ribble in Lancashire. The hall is set in 178 acres. Waddow Hall is reached by rail and road and is only a 15 minute walk from the centre of Clitheroe. Take the road to Waddington from Clitheroe. Waddow Hall is 1½ miles down the road on the left. Large Parking area at the Hall. Follow the signs.

HALL ACCOMMODATION

YOUR TUTORS FOR THE WEEKEND

Steve Tilston Ask anyone on the English folk scene who is their favourite guitarist, singer and songwriter and most will say **Steve Tilston**. Steve Tilston is one of our most celebrated songsmiths, widely recognised for his superb guitar skills. Steve will be leading the advanced guitar sessions all weekend and in addition, he will be hosting the song writing sessions.

Brian Peters is an international performer having toured in America. Well known on the British folk scene, Brian will teach advanced Melodeon techniques and also have his Anglo Concertina on hand to help any budding player.

Phil Brown Phil has been a musician all his life. From his youth playing in the Brass section in his local Brass Band, to being a master whistle player. Phil founded and runs the Big Whistle music company in East Lancashire. Phil is the leader of Shake-A-Leg Band. Phil presents The Drift on BBC Radio Lancashire.

Will Lang is a graduate of the Folkworks teaching programmes in the North East. He is reckoned to be one of the finest Bodhran players of the current generation. Will performs with his own band The Park Bench Social Club and is also part of the group Mabon.

Emily Portman graduated through the Folkworks college of music. Emily is the lead singer in the group Rubus. She is a highly regarded tutor in the ranks of a new generation of voice tutors.

Roger Purves is a Mandolin player of renown who is also a graduate of Folkworks. Roger is a master of the styles and techniques of Mandolin playing and is a welcome addition to the **Folkus** team.

Robin Shepherd is returning to Waddow by popular demand. Robin teaches Melodeon and is a fine Fiddle player. Robin can dance a remarkable solo Morris Jig whilst playing the Fiddle. A good old English tradition!

Claire Smith Claire is the organiser of the Nantwich Fiddle Festival. Claire is also frequently in demand to play in backing groups to touring artists and recently supported Joan Baez on her tour of the UK. Claire will be teaching advanced fiddle techniques.

Jenny Coxon will be joining the team on the Sunday to demonstrate Dulcimer techniques. **Folkus** Dulcimer players will be welcome.

The **Folkus** regular tutors will be: **Derek Gifford** who is a popular performer on the folk club circuit. He will be teaching intermediate styles of guitar techniques. **Rusty & Stu Wright** are tutors teaching Guitar, Fiddle, Anglo Concertina and Spoons **Fred Rose** is a multi instrumentalist playing Fiddle, Guitar and Whistle. **Jenny Shotliff** is one of the new generation of Fiddle tutors. **Alan Bell** is a Folklorist, English Concertina player, singer songwriter and Chair of **Folkus**.
